Special Benefits for Eligible Members of Tribes

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) includes information that is specific to American Indians and Alaska Natives. This fact sheet describes what American Indians and Alaska Natives can expect if they purchase a health insurance plan from Your Health Idaho.

SHOP. COMPARE. CHOOSE.

Certain American Indians and Alaska Natives can buy a health insurance plan through Your Health Idaho and receive the benefits described below:

- **No healthcare expenses, depending on income:** American Indians and Alaska Natives who earn up to \$70,650 for a family of four do not have to pay certain out-of-pocket costs, such as copays, if they buy an insurance plan through Your Health Idaho.
- **Buy insurance anytime:** Members of Idaho's tribes are not limited by enrollment periods. They may enroll in a plan at any time throughout the year.
- **Continue services:** If you enroll in a health insurance plan sold on Your Health Idaho, you can receive, or continue receiving services from Indian Health Service, tribal health programs or urban Indian health programs.

American Indians and Alaska Natives are not required to purchase a health insurance plan, as most other Americans are. There is no penalty for American Indians or Alaska Natives that do not have health insurance.
